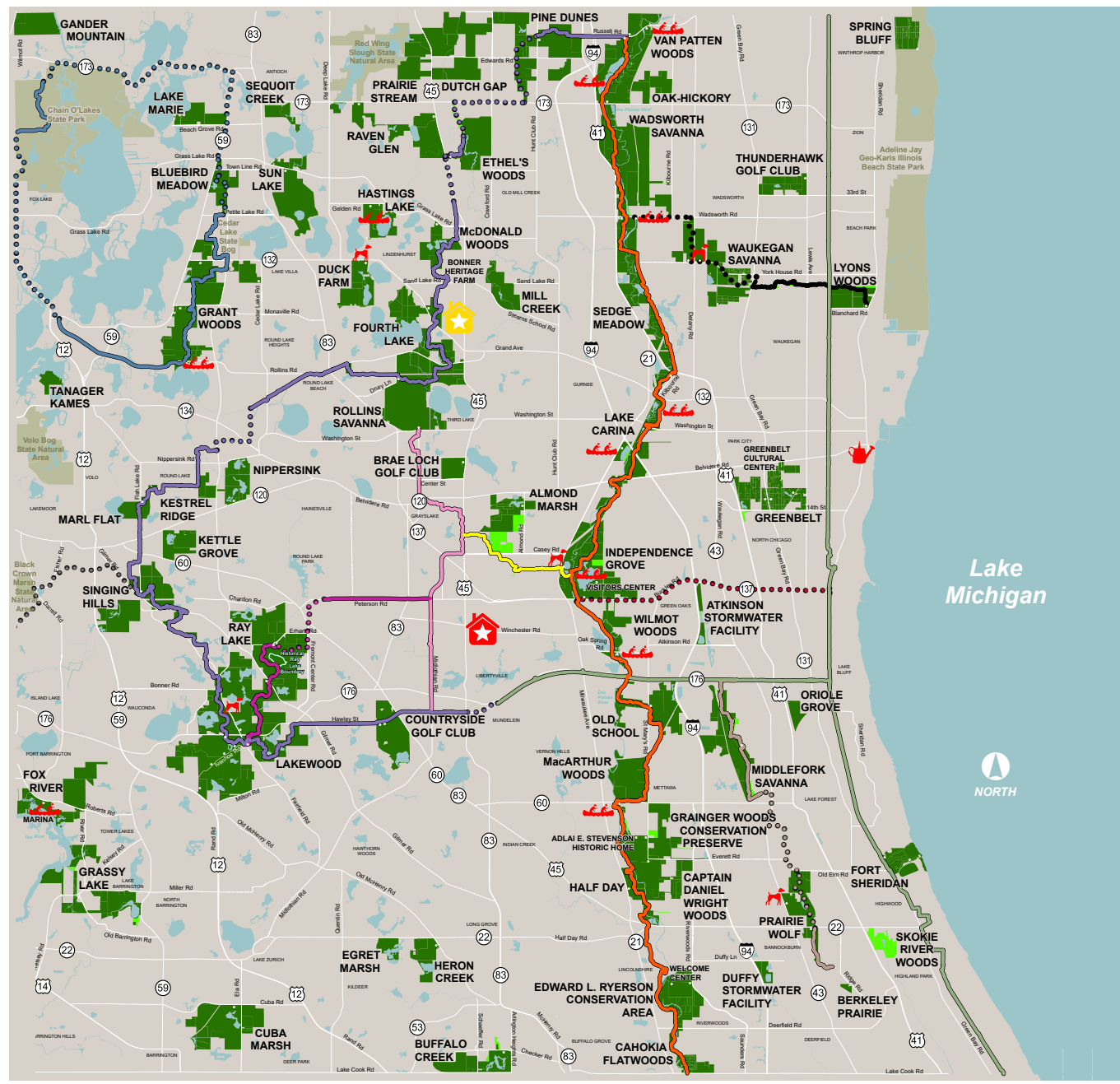


CHART LEGEND
